Set up the game for you, your family, or your friends to play. Hide each of the plant cards around your home or learning space.


Assign each player a pollinator card. See who can find the plant that matches their pollinator first!





Extender Activity:








Sunflower

A brightly colored yellow flower that smells good and produces big seeds.






Titan Arum

You are attracted to pale red, purple, pink, or white flowers that smell good. Your favorite is dense blazing star!




You are a:
