

About Hügelkultur Gardening

Hügelkultur is a gardening method that creates a layered hill or mound for gardening. At the base of the mound, logs, branches, and other woody materials help to create the form, and also break down slowly over time into nutrients for the garden. Organic materials like grasses and food scraps are layered on top of the logs to create another layer that also breaks down into nutrient rich compost. Soil is placed on top of the mound to cover the composting materials and to provide a surface for planting. Plants are then added onto the mound, which can include anything from small herbs to large trees.
